iPhone and Android malware that tricks victims into scanning their faces and ID documents, which are believed to be used to generate deepfakes for unauthorised banking access. It was reported that it was doing more damage to Android users than those with iPhones. Google has now responded to the report. The named 'GoldPickaxe', which employs social engineering schemes to trick users, was spotted by Singapore-based Group-IB and is said to be a part of a malware suit.

CHANDIGARH: In a new twist after a meeting with the BJP to the row over Chandigarh's mayoral election last month, BJP's Manoj Sonkar resigned from the post late Sunday, a day before Supreme Court is due to hear a case involving the defeat of AAP-Congress candidate Kuldeep Kumar after eight votes were controversially declared invalid. Sources said Sonkar resigned

The 2024 contest for Baramati will be one of most keenly the watched battles. On Friday, without naming Nationalist names, Congress Party (NCP) president Ajit Pawar made an emotional appeal to his constituents to elect a "first timer" who is though surrounded by "experienced people." Ajit Pawar's speech fuelled speculation that the party will field his wife Sunetra against his cousin, the incumbent Baramati MP, Supriva Sule. The



used the occasion to launch a chariot that will run through the constituency talking up the social initiatives taken up by Sunetra Pawar. While speaking to his party workers, a day after Maharashtra Assembly Speaker Rahul Narwekar

would field a candidate who has not contested an election earlier, but that person would have the support of those with ample experience. People, he added, should vote for his candidate as if he himself were in the fray.

"As party workers, you should tell voters without hesitation that the elected MP from here will work more for the development as compared to the one you have been electing for the last three to four terms.

Tell the voters that this is a promise to them from Ajit Pawar that even if our candidate is a first

timer, they are surrounded by people with ample experience of winning polls." Although she has stayed away from active politics so far, Sunetra Pawar, 60, hailed from a political family before marrying into another one. Her brother Padamsinh Patil is a former minister while her nephew Jagjitsinha Rana Padamsinh Patil is a BJP from Osmanabad. The Pawar couple's elder son, Parth, had unsuccessfully contested the 2019 Lok Sabha elections from

Maval. The Pawar clan may have had a serious political cleave in the last one year, their personal relations have remained close.

About two weeks after taking office as Jharkhand's new chief minister, Champai Soren appointed seven other MLAs including incarcerated the brother of former chief minister Hemant Soren as ministers. Eleven ministers, including the chief minister, will make up the new cabinet; one position will be held open, as it was in the previous Hemant Soren government, for future entry. Champai, one Congress and one RJD MLA, had taken an oath on February 2. Soon after the results of the 2019 assembly elections were announced, the JMM-Congress-RJD "mahagathbandhan sarkar" agreed upon a cabinet slot sharing formula of 7:4:1. They maintained it on Friday as well. Congress MLAs

protested at Champai's decision to remove JMM's Latehar MLA Baidyanath Ram from the cabinet at the last minute, despite Raj Bhavan having issued an appointment warrant in his name, which thwarted JMM's attempts to fill the 12th ministerial berth. Even though RJD only has one MLA out of the 81 members of the house, during Hemant's government, MLAs from JMM and Congress were interested in the open cabinet position. The Congress

claim to the 12th ministerial slot in question. JMM's decision to dismiss Ram was criticized by the BJP, who described it as "an insult to the 50-lakh strong scheduled caste population of the state." Siddaramaiah accuses central govt of discrimination

Siddaramaiah's budget on Friday launched a scathing attack on the Bharatiya Janata Party-led Union government, accusing it of discrimination in devolution of funds. "The collection of cess and surcharges for 2023-24 has increased by 153%... If cesses and surcharges are shared with the states, a total of ?11,34,301 crore was available for devolution for all states. Due to non-sharing of cesses and surcharges by the Union government, the state suffered a loss of ?45,322 crore in the last seven years," he said. The CM blamed the Centre's "unscientific implementation of GST" for the losses. "Unscientific implementation of GST, increase in cesses and surcharges and change in allocation formula- these three injustices meted out by the central government coupled with the short release of funds to the states have adversely affected the financial strength of all the states of the country. As the ruling party in several states are same as that in the Centre, these states are unable to raise their voice against the injustices meted out against them." He further alleged that the state suffered staggering losses due to changes in the method of calculating state income and the use of the 2011 census instead of the 1971 census, resulting in a shortfall of 62,098 crore under the devolution of Central Taxes over six years.

Delhi: Anti-rabies serum must be made available at all sub-health centers, primary health centers, and urban primary health centers, per a directive from the Center to all states and Union territories. According to the National Health Mission, financial assistance would be given for the purchase of the antirabies serum. When there is a possibility of serious exposure following contact with a rabid animal or when an animal is thought to be rabid, anti-rabies serum is given. In severe cases, it should be administered in addition to the rabies vaccine. According to experts, the majority of primary health centers do not carry it, and each dose costs more over Rs 10,000. In a recent letter to the states and UTs, an NHM official said that rabies is a fatal viral infection and that having access to medications for both prevention and treatment is crucial to preventing the financial and psychological toll that rabies has on families.

Modi govt did for India-Greece ties what others didn't in 40 years

Greek Prime Minister Kyriakos Mitsotakis will be the chief guest at the annual Raisina Dialogue held in New Delhi from 21 to 24 February 2024. This would be the third consecutive year of having a European guest at the summit – Delhi hosted European Commission president Ursula Von der Leyen in 2022 and Italian PM Georgia Meloni in 2023. The business delegation accompanying Mitsotakis will visit Mumbai and Bengaluru as well and is likely to explore economic opportunities in sectors such as construction material manufacturing, food and beverages, defence, renewable energy sources, high technology, agriculture, shipping, and tourism. Mitsotakis' visit marks a significant upgrade to India-Greece bilateral ties. It also builds on Delhi's strategic outreach to Southern Europe and the Mediterranean within the expanding diplomatic footprint in Europe at large. India and Greece are among the world's oldest democracies, both being ancient cultures and civilisations that reinvented their ethos through various epochs. Early Greeks knew of the river Ganges and called it Phison and the great Greek political philosopher Plato knew of the Indian tradition of mystic meditations. The latter's celebrated work The Republic concludes with a reflection on the transmigration of souls, which has an indelible mark of Indian spiritualism. From Mauryan-era trade to the fascinating chronicles of Alexander the Great, linkages with Greece were significant in ancient India. Despite sharing such a rich history of economic and cultural exchanges, the ties between the two countries never moved beyond a point. PM Narendra Modi has carved the space to upgrade the ties between the two countries to a strategic partnership that's suitable to today's fastchanging geopolitical context. His efforts have opened up newer pathways of cooperation amid fresh challenges. From India's perspective, Greece was the only natural ally with whom strategic cooperation had not been given the same attention as Cyprus, Italy, Spain, and France. For the first time in 40 years, an Indian PM visited Greece when Modi went to Athens in August 2023, where he was rightly conferred with Greece's Grand Cross of the Order of Honour, the country's second-highest civilian honour. This upgradation to a strategic partnership was built on the groundwork laid by External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar in 2021 when he paid an official visit to Greece. The following year, the Greek parliament ratified the International Solar Alliance (ISA), a treaty-based organisation that was proposed by Modi in 2015. In March 2022, Jaishankar's visit was returned by his then-Greek counterpart Nikos Dendias. This slew of developments has been instrumental in enhancing ties between the two countries. It opened new vistas to expand areas of convergence in not only trade and joint military exercises but also connectivity projects, which could help in the full utilisation of Greece's strategic location as a gateway to Europe for India and the Gulf countries. The much-touted India-Middle East-Europe Economic Corridor (IMEC) was conceived on the same logic of connecting diverse geographies of South and West Asia to Europe through Haifa in Israel and Piraeus in Greece. The region is a prospective yet contested pathway for new, competing intercontinental connectivity corridors. Many wrote off the IMEC when Hamas' brutal attack on Israel on 7 October 2023 put the normalisation process on hold. But remarks made by Indian finance minister Nirmala Sitharaman in Parliament and Modi in the United Arab Emirates have roused fresh interest in the project. It is likely to be back on track once the situation in the Middle East improves. Northern Cvprus declared independence in 1983 with Turkish support, sealing the fate of the region in a perpetual disquiet – the power balance in the Eastern Mediterranean.

Treating farmers like criminals

Farmer movements are once again in full swing, especially regarding Minimum Support Price (MSP) and other demands. Farmers from many states including Punjab, Haryana, Western Uttar Pradesh are moving towards Delhi. Not only this, the BJP and Prime Minister Narendra Modi himself, who used to demand implementation of the recommendations of the Swaminathan Commission before becoming the Prime Minister, are now seen turning away from the same

Walmart seeks out new **Indian suppliers**



Delhi: Walmart, the massive US retailer, is relying more and more on India, one of its main growth regions, and is looking to connect with new suppliers there as it attempts to diversify its supply chain and lessen its need in places like China. In order to fulfill its goal of buying \$10 billion worth of goods from India annually by 2027, the corporation would also require new suppliers. The retailer is highlighting its growing focus on India, where CEO Doug McMillon stated that production capacity is expanding and scaling, by holding its inaugural growth summit there. India is the only market to host such an event outside of the US, Chile, and Mexico. Beyond collaborating with export suppliers, the company is looking to form partnerships with regional entrepreneurs who are developing supply chain solutions as part of the India market. Delhi: TVS Motor became the sixth Indian automaker to reach Rs 1 lakh crore in market worth. The companv's market cap was Rs 1 lakh crore, second to Eicher Motors Rs 1.1 lakh crore. Maruti Suzuki leads with Rs 3.6 lakh crore, followed by Tata Motors with Rs 3.4 lakh crore. Bajaj Auto and M&M rank third and fourth with Rs 2.4 and Rs 2.3 lakh crore, respectively. After TVS acquired 28.57% of the non-profit Indian Foundation for Quality Management, its market cap rose. TVS paid Rs 25 crore for 2.5 crore Rs 10 equity shares. IFQM will allot shares by April 15 within 60 days of subscription payment. The transaction is related partly because TVS chairman emeritus and MD Venu Srinivasan is also an IFQM director. The twowheeler giant's Q3 FY24 net profit rose 68% to Rs 593 crore from Rs 353 crore.

To save expenses, SpiceJet would eliminate 1,400 positions.

Delhi: As part of its turnaround strategy, low-cost carrier SpiceJet intends to fire 1.400 workers by the end of March, or around 15% of its workforce. The airline announced its confirmation of the decision, claiming that it will enable them to save up to Rs 100 crore every year. There are about 9,000 workers at the cashstrapped airline right now. "It currently operates about 32 aircraft and another ten aircraft on wet-lease, that have come with pilots and cabin crew," stated a spokesperson for the airline. They also mentioned that as of March 2019, the airline was flying with a fleet of 120 aircraft prior to Covid. Only non-operational workers will be affected by the layoffs; pilots and cabin crew will not be among them.

Tesla wants Indian rooftop solar panel partner

Delhi: An unidentified source says Tesla is actively recruiting Indian rooftop solar panel manufacturers. This partnership would involve the partner manufacturing and installing, while Tesla provided technology and sales skills. The corporation has informed the government of its ambitions and is seeking subsidies and grants. Tesla makes solar roofs, Powerwalls, and solar panels in addition to electric cars. Following a 59% drop in US solar installs in the December quarter, Tesla made this strategic step. Tesla has a major opportunity in India's rooftop solar incentives. Tata Power Solar, Adani Solar, Servotech Power Systems, and Waaree Energies are Indian rooftop solar players. The US

Delhi: Some non-life due to modifications insurers want to use 'cohort-based pricing' to raise premiums for plans with high claims. Many health insurance businesses have claims that exceed premiums, causing pricing issues. Meanwhile, high premiums are driving people away. At a recent regulator meeting, solo health insurance companies endorsed the approach. Insurers say some policies pay claims for over a decade. In addition, many who have paid for decades without a claim are having their premium skyrocket

and increased senior rates. "While this proposal may make actuarial sense, insurance is for unexpected risks and this goes against the principle of risk distribution in insurance," stated a public sector

general insurance company official. The biggest concern is that the measure will raise insurance costs for the poor. Punitive premium loadings at renewal disproportionately affect chronic health patients. Digit insurance spokesperson: This method wors-

In boost for India, US House passes bill on Quad

US-India-Australia-Japan Quad alliance, the US House of Representative has passed the "Quad Bill" with a near-unanimous vote to establish a body facilitating closer ties between the four countries. The bill was cleared by a roll call vote of 379 in favour and 39 against. The bill, officially called the 'Strengthen US-Australia-India-Japan Cooperation', directs the US State Department to submit a roadmap to increase engagement with Quad members. The bill seeks to foster closer collaboration between Quad members with an aim to strengthen the alliance across various cooperation areas. It proposes that Biden administration must develop strategy to address cooperation on issues including (1) preparing



for the next pandemic, (2) co-developing new innovative technologies, and (3) deepening economic engagement and integration. Greater cooperation between Quad nations matter since the group is seen as a counterweight to China in the Indo-Pacific region. It has openly advocated for a "free and open Indo-Pacific". Maldives ties shaky, India doubles aid

Delhi: Despite strained relations with the Maldives, Delhi will prioritize Indian Ocean development projects. India increased its 2023-24 Maldives budget from Rs 400 crore to Rs 770 crore. Second only to Bhutan and Nepal, it has allocated Rs 600 crore for the Maldives in 2024-25. India has not let disputes with Male, particularly in defense and security cooperation, impede the \$500 million Greater Male Connectivity Project, its largest infrastructure project. Maldives allocations are grants, not loans. Bhutan retained its top budgeted allocation, with India allocating Rs 2,068 crore to Thimphu. Nepal gets Rs 700 crore. Including Bhutan's loan, India's 2024-25 estimate for grant and loan assistance to foreign governments is Rs 5,667 crore. This is 874 crore less than last year's revised projection. In 2024-25, India allocated Rs 250 crore for conflict-torn Myanmar, down from Rs 370 crore last year.

In the 2023-24 batch, 5035 undergraduates (15 Indians) and 15 postgraduates (8 Indians) were accepted. The UG program has 22 African students, 40% of whom are women.

WWF India Suspension Lifted Immediately

Amateur wrestling's international governing body, United World Wrestling, lifted the Wrestling Federation of India (WFI) ban immediately. The WFI was provisionally suspended by UWW on August 23, 2018, after the Indian body failed to hold an election. A UWW Disciplinary Chamber statement said the body was provisionally suspended because the situation in the federation lasted at least six months. The same source indicated that the UWW Bureau reviewed the suspension and agreed to lift it under certain conditions. The Athletes' Commission elections were rescheduled by WFI. Active athletes or retirees under four years will serve on this commission. In all cases, only athletes can vote. Elections can be held during trials or senior national championships, but they must be held by July 1, 2024. "The WFI must immediately provide UWW with written guarantees that all wrestlers will be considered for participation without discrimination in all WFI events, including Olympic Games trials and other major national and international events. The three athletes who criticized the former President are included in this non-discrimination "official statement. The judgment by UWW means that Indian wrestlers who couldn't compete under their country's flag can now do so at the next event. While suspended, Indian wrestlers competed under the UFF flag. Indian competitors who won the gold medal were not allowed to perform the national anthem. After the global wrestling body's judgment, such arrangements are void.

No free private schools for EWS kids in Maharashtra if govt. schools are nearby

Educational experts criticized the decision as violating the RTE Act. According to recent gazette amendments to Maharashtra's school education department's regulations, economically disadvantaged students will lose free access to private schools under the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 (RTE) from the next academic year if there is a government school nearby. The amendment prohibits underprivileged children from attending an unassisted private school in their area under the 25% RTE quota if there is a government or government-aided school within a kilometer. 



Woman ends life after husband snatches her mobile phone

Rachna Sahu died by suicide in Bhilai after her husband confiscated her phone. She was found hanging in their house. The police sealed the room and sent the body to Lal Bahadur Shastri Hospital for post-mortem examination. Their daughter, reels, Instagram, arguments, living on the second floor with in-laws, neighbours, and passing away were factors leading to the suicide. Woman ends life after husband snatches her mobile phone A woman died by suicide in her house after her husband snatched the device, in the steel city -Bhilai. The woman is survived by a five-year-old daughter. Before the police arrived, locals had already brought down the woman's body from the noose. Subsequently, the police sealed the room and sent the body to Lal Bahadur Shastri Hospital for post-mortem examination. Supela SHO Durgesh Sharma informed that prima facie, the reason behind the suicide appears to be related to the mobile phone. Upon arrival at the scene, it was discovered that Rachna Sahu, wife of Bhupendra Sahu, a tiles worker, was found hanging.During interrogation, Bhupendra told the police that they had been married for six years and had a five-year-old daughter. On Friday afternoon, he confiscated Rachna's smartphone and left home. Only his mother, sister-in-law and their children were at home at the time. Approximately four hours later, at 7 p.m., he received a call informing him that Rachna's body was found hanging, the SHO said. Upon returning home, Bhupendra found his wife Rachna's body. She had a sari noose around her neck. Bhupendra explained to the police that Rachna would spend the entire day engrossed in her mobile phone, neglecting household chores and childcare responsibilities. She was focused on creating reels, Instagram videos, and posting them, he told the police. He had repeatedly asked her to limit her phone usage, leading to frequent arguments between them. When Rachna refused to list n, Bhupendra, in anger, confiscated her phone on Friday, her husband told the police. Rachna lived on the second floor of the house with her husband, while the in-laws lived downstairs. On Friday evening, only Rachna's motherin-law, sister-in-law, and their children were at home. Rachna took her daughter upstairs, locked her in a room, and then went alone to another room.When the child cried, the mother-in-law and sister-in-law rushed upstairs and found Rachna hanging from the noose. They made noise, and neighbours arrived. They brought her down from the noose, but by then, she had already passed away.

Tamil Nadu man facing five revenge-murder cases nabbed while plotting 6th hit

CHENNAI: A 42-year- ed killer of his elder old man, who was brother and returned arrested in connection with five murders and released on bail, was stopped in his tracks on Friday while planning his sixth hit. All his six targets, including the five victims, were named as accused in the murder of the man's elder brother in 2012. In the intervening 11 years, S Suresh Kumar of PV Kalathur in Nithyanandam Chengalpet murdered all but one. Every time he got out on bail, he killed another suspect- Kumar


